

## OEC to OFA L3 RECERTIFICATION COURSE

This 2.5 day re-certification course is a 'review course' not a 'course of instruction'. It is intended for pre-qualified first-aid professionals who actively work in an environment where responding to medical emergencies is a common and expected occurrence. Essentially this program is reserved for individuals who are experienced pre-hospital care providers such as ski-patrollers, search & rescue personnel, paramedics and other experienced first-aid providers. While the Outdoor Emergency Care (OEC) and Non-Urban Emergency Medical Responder (NUEMR) curriculum covers and exceeds many of the OFA Level 3 subjects, in preparation for this re-certification course participants must review OFA protocols and procedures prior to attending the in-class sessions. This is a demanding and fast-paced program that requires you to commit the time necessary to assimilate the theoretical information in the OFA textbook. Please note that only certain subjects will be reviewed during the in-class sessions and prior to the evaluation process.
